Treasurer's Report

- As expected, the account grew over the summer because of parade income, we gained almost \$3,000. We're still negative for the year, but we started with a lot in the bank.

 I remember someone saying they do this every year, so we're probably just at their mercy.

 well.
- The reason practice space expenses are a negative number for this period (meaning they

- We still have costume expenses that Mary needs to submit.
