New Brighton 8/14/2021 - Yes, Julie will apply

Vadnais Heights 8/15/2021 - No, we will not do this parade

State Fair, date TBD - Yes, Julie will apply for the first Friday of the fair

Osseo 9/11/2021 - Holding off until later to decide on September parades.

St Helena 9/18/2021 - Date not certain. Holding off until later to decide on September parades.

North St Paul 9/23/2021 - Holding off until later to decide on September parades.

## Much discussion ensued, with the following takeaways:

- Connie suggested we all need to reach out to people personally to attend parades. She questioned how picky we need to be about membership status. After discussion, it was determined that we can allow non-members to participate in parades as long as they wear the uniform.
- Julie questioned how we should manage parade incentives. After discussing our options and how our children feel, we will keep it at a DQ card after 3 parades.
- We need to change our water routine due to Covid. We can ask people to bring their own water labeled with their name that will be kept in the wagon, and we can bring some extra in case people forget.

- Julie will bring the sign, wagons, etc to the first parade. We will need to schedule parade managers for future parades.
- Connie is happy to ride her 6' giraffe, and maybe taller if there are enough other tall giraffe riders. We will talk to other giraffe riders to get participants. Connie will act as giraffe wrangler with support from others.
- At each parade, we will alter the routine as necessary to accommodate the comfort levels of those in attendance
  with regards to proximity and hand-holding. Masks are optional but recommended for those who are not
  vaccinated.
